DRESSING GUIDE - DRESS REHEARSAL & PERFORMANCES

Ballet: *NUTCRACKER*

Role: **Mouse (Boy)**

Dancewear

Tights: Grey; tights must not have runs or holes
Shoes: Grey; shoes should be clean and free of holes; drawstrings must be tucked in and taped inside shoes; no bows.

Makeup**

Base: Yes

Eye Liner: Black Pencil

Eye Shadow: Browns

Mascara: Black

Lipstick: Pink

Blush: Pink

****Designated Mouse makeup artists will do mouse noses and whiskers backstage in dressing rooms. Please send Black Eyeliner Pencil and Pink Lipstick with your child.****

Hair

Hair slicked back.

Accessories

None.

NOTES:

- ❖ Drawstrings and/or ribbons on shoes must be tucked in and taped.
- ❖ Tights must be form-fitting and not baggy.
- ❖ No other jewelry or adornment will be allowed (e.g., watches, bracelets, necklaces, rings, glitter, etc.)
- ❖ No eating or drinking in costume (this includes chewing gum)!
- ❖ No food or drink allowed in dressing room.
- ❖ No costumes allowed in audience (this includes headpieces, leotard & tights, ballet shoes, stage make-up); only "audience dress" is allowed anywhere beyond backstage.
